English

This term we have lots of exciting activities planned for your child which will be linked to our fantastic book 'Boy at the Back of the Class' by Onjali Q. Rauf. This story is a child's perspective on the refugee crisis, highlighting the importance of friendship and kindness in a world that doesn't always make sense.



Maths

After the MTC, we will be learning about shape, statistics and position and direction, before moving onto consolidating our year 4 maths topics.



Multiplication Tables Check

In week 2, the children will be completing their MTC test. This is a national test which the children have been working really hard for. Thank you for all the support and time you have spent learning times tables with your children. We feel that the children are very prepared for the test now.



Science

We will be consolidating our science learning that we have done this year and will revisit living things and their habitats and group living things in a classification chart. We will also revisit the digestive system.

Computing

Computing this term is online safety. Children will learn how to stay safe online.

Music

This term we will be learning how to compose music using rhythm grids.

French

This term we will learn how to use French verbs when talking or writing about celebrations.

History

We will continue with our local History topic of how Bristol played a role in the chocolate industry.

Geography

This term we will be exploring the major environmental regions of Europe, Russia, North and South America.

Art

We will continue learning about the Austrian artist Hundertwasser, famous for his architecture and paintings. We will follow his lead and be inspired by nature to design our own building complete without any straight lines, and we will explore 'cool' and 'warm' colours. We will produce a piece of artwork inspired by Hundertwasser.

Religion and Worldviews

We will be continuing to explore the question: does the language of scripture matter? We will explore how some religious communities use scripture and how the same scripture can be expressed in different ways.

DT

We will be evaluating a range of existing torches and designing a functional torch for a target audience.
